It is our goal for each patient to have the safest, most stress-free experience possible. We follow the American Animal Hospital Association's highest surgical standards for the safety and comfort of your pet. All pets scheduled for general anesthesia have a preoperative exam and blood panel performed. This assesses basic metabolic function, complete blood count, and liver and kidney values. It allows us to ascertain there are no underlying issues with organ function, blood imbalances, or anemia that could cause complications. If problems are found which may significantly increase the risk of anesthesia or warrant additional care, these problems will be discussed with you prior to proceeding.

Your pet's past anesthetic history, breed, pre-existing conditions, and age are all factors used to determine your pet's personalized anesthesia protocol. Cardiopulmonary (heart and respiratory) monitoring equipment is used in all extended procedures as an added precaution. An IV solution will be administered while your pet is under to ensure proper electrolytes and hydration – this will require shaving a section of one or two legs. We will utilize the proper surgical medications to keep your pet comfortable and pain-free.

Surgical admission is 7:00-8:30 AM and is designed to reduce your pet's anxiety and allow for pre-anesthetic examination and testing. Please feel free to contact us at any time for an update on your pet at 770-476-3317.

We recommend the use of surgical laser for most procedures. The laser allows for less bleeding, inflammation, and discomfort and results in increased healing time. Laser use is an additional fee starting at \$59.75.

There are inherent risks with the use of anesthesia, and Duluth Animal Hospital takes every precaution to lessen these risks. Our objective is to provide the safest and most comfortable procedure possible for your pet.

I understand that there are certain risks to anesthesia that could involve bodily injury or death to my pet, and that these are present in any procedure involving general or IV anesthesia. I agree to the use of anesthesia as considered necessary and advisable by the veterinarian, and herby give my informed consent. I also understand that full payment (cash, Mastercard, Visa, Discover, American Express, or Care Credit) is due at the time of pick-up. Surgical discharge is weekdays until 6PM unless prior arrangements have been made with the veterinarian.
